**In Matthew 11:28-30 The Lord Jesus makes two passionate invitations, which will lead you into a relationship, as His growing disciple.**

**You're invited, but will you accept?**

**I. An invitation to \_\_\_\_\_**

**A. The setting of the first invitation is Matthew 11:7-27**

**B. Specifics of this first invitation (v.28)**

1. *Come to me*

2. *all who labor and are heavy laden*

3. *and I will give you rest*

**C. You're invited, will you accept?**

**II. An invitation to \_\_\_\_\_ (Vs. 29-30)**

**A. The setting of the second invitation**

**B. The second invitation is expressed in two statements (v. 29)**

1. *Take my yoke upon you,*

2. *and learn from me*

**C. And is supported by three powerful reasons (Vs. 29-30)**

1. *for I am gentle and lowly in heart,*

2. *and you will find rest for your souls.*

3. *For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light.*

**D. You're invited, will you accept?**

**Message Summary-** To the weary the Lord Jesus makes two passionate invitations:

<b>An Invitation to Salvation</b>	<b>An Invitation to Discipleship</b>
"Come to Me"	"Take my yoke upon you and learn from me"
Find rest from religion	Find rest from self-life
Requires a prayer of salvation	Requires a prayer of commitment
